## Article Review Order

1. Papers submitted for publication are reviewed for the purpose of its peer evaluation for no more than 3 weeks from the date of submission to the editors.
2. All the reviewers are recognized experts on the subject of peer-reviewed materials who have scientific publications on the subject in the past three years. The peer-review is carried out mainly by members of the editorial board, responsible for the journal's columns which correspond to their scientific specialization.
3. A reviewer pays attention to the following basic criteria that the publication must comply with:
  - 3.1 Paper subject must correspond to the scientific profile of the journal.
  - 3.2 Articles must be written in accordance with all the necessary components (abstract, keywords, information about the author, etc.); texts must have the required volume and correspond to the rules of the Russian or another language.
  - 3.3 The presented material should be relevant and have novelty.
  - 3.4 The submitted papers must include professional knowledge of scientific terminology and the validity of the author's conclusions and theoretical foundations; empirical evidence must be interpreted in terms of scientific methods.
  - 3.5 Articles should be of a high degree of competence of the author in the chosen field of study, including knowing of the basic scientific developments (published in Russian and foreign languages), as well as modern approaches to solving the problem set up by the author (published in Russian and foreign languages).
  - 3.6 Papers should include sufficient source base and represent the expertise in working with sources. The translation of texts and definitions into foreign languages must be adequate and faithful.
  - 3.7 Authors should be disassociated from ideological and religious prejudice and religious and apologetic approaches to the treatment of a problem.
4. In his or her expert report, the reviewer should clearly formulate a proposal for the publication of the article or its refusal.
5. In accordance with the review the editorial board jointly makes the final decision about the publication or rejection of the article.

6. Author shall be notified of the editorial board's decision within 10 days.
7. The editorial board sent reviews or substantiated refusal to authors, as well as sent review copies to the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation when prompted.
8. Reviews are stored in the publishing house for 5 years.

Article review order was adopted at a meeting of the editorial board on February 10, 2001. The new edition was approved on September 2, 2015.
